1302. DECLARATION OF INTERESTS

Councillors were asked to disclosure any interests on matters to be considered at this meeting and reminded to update changes in their interests within 28 days. No interests were declared.

1303. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Standing Orders were suspended to allow the public to speak

The public raised the following concerns about the Punch Bowl development:

In principle in the main residents agree with the development after their concerns are answered

A resident is concerned about the privacy issues relating to people overlooking his property from the Velux windows in the development.

A resident has used part of the land outlined in the Planning Application for his own personal use over many years and his concerned about the loss of the amenity.

Residents are concerned what will happen to any excess water once the pub cellars are abandoned.

Residents raised concern the current barn was not structurally sound enough to convert.

Residents are concerned about the loss of parking opposite the Punch Bowl.

Residents from St Helen's Crescent have been able to cut through the Punch Bowl carpark for many years this convenient short cut will be lost.

Residents are concerned that there have been previous reports of asbestos being found in the Punch Bowl kitchens.

Residents were concerned that the sewers may not be able to accommodate the new development.

The electricity cables in Churchtown are lower than the current regulations and need to be considered while the Punch Bowl is being developed.

Application Number: 21/01117/FUL

Proposal: Proposed change of use and alterations to form 3 new dwellings with

associated car parking and landscaping

Location: Punch Bowl Inn 5 - 9 Church Street Churchtown Preston Lancashire
